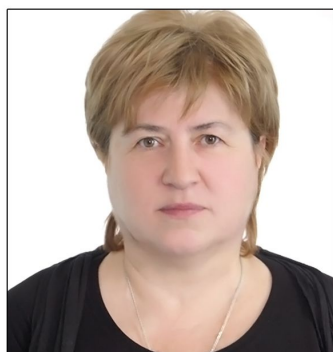

THE DEPARTMENT OF INTERNAL DISEASES N2



The Department of Internal Diseases N2 was founded on the basis of the Hospital Therapy Department in 1921. The heads of the department were Professors Spiridon Virsaladze, Mikheil Tsinamdzgvirshvili (1930-1956) and Konstantine Virsaladze (1956-1973). In 1973 the department was divided into two departments headed by Givi (Grigol) Bakhtadze and Konstantine Virsaladze.

In 1994 Prof. Alexander Kistauri became the head of the department. In 2021 Prof. Irma Tchokhonelidze became the head of the Department of Internal Diseases N2. From 1974 many famous Professors Ioseb Javakhishvili, Alexander Anasashvili, Bondo Kobulia, Assoc. Professors Varlam Borjadze, Avtandil Kurkhuli, Murman Mamaladze, Natela Gogiberidze, Manana Zodelava, Assistants: Ana Mekvabishvili, Luba Tevdorashvili, Merab Kavtaradze, Irakli Tatishvili, Irina Andronikashvili, Irina Kapetivadze, Assistant Professors: Nato Katamadze, Nana Begishvili, Marina Jibladze, Researchers: Lia Ninua, Nana Kokrashvili, Ketevan Zakaraia were involved in the scientific activities of the department.

Fundamental and actual scientific research were delivered in general therapy, cardiology, gastroenterology, pulmonology, nephrology, endocrinology, and rheumatology. Monographs and manuals were published by the academic staff of the department. Scientific-research institutions in parasitology, clinical and experimental cardiology were established by the academic staff of the department.

Nowadays Assoc. Prof. Nona Kakauridze, Assistant Professors Darejan Gabunia, Maka Gegevana and Researcher Ketevan Zakaraia are involved in the academic work of the department. Professor Alexander Kistauri was honored with the Emeritus title.
